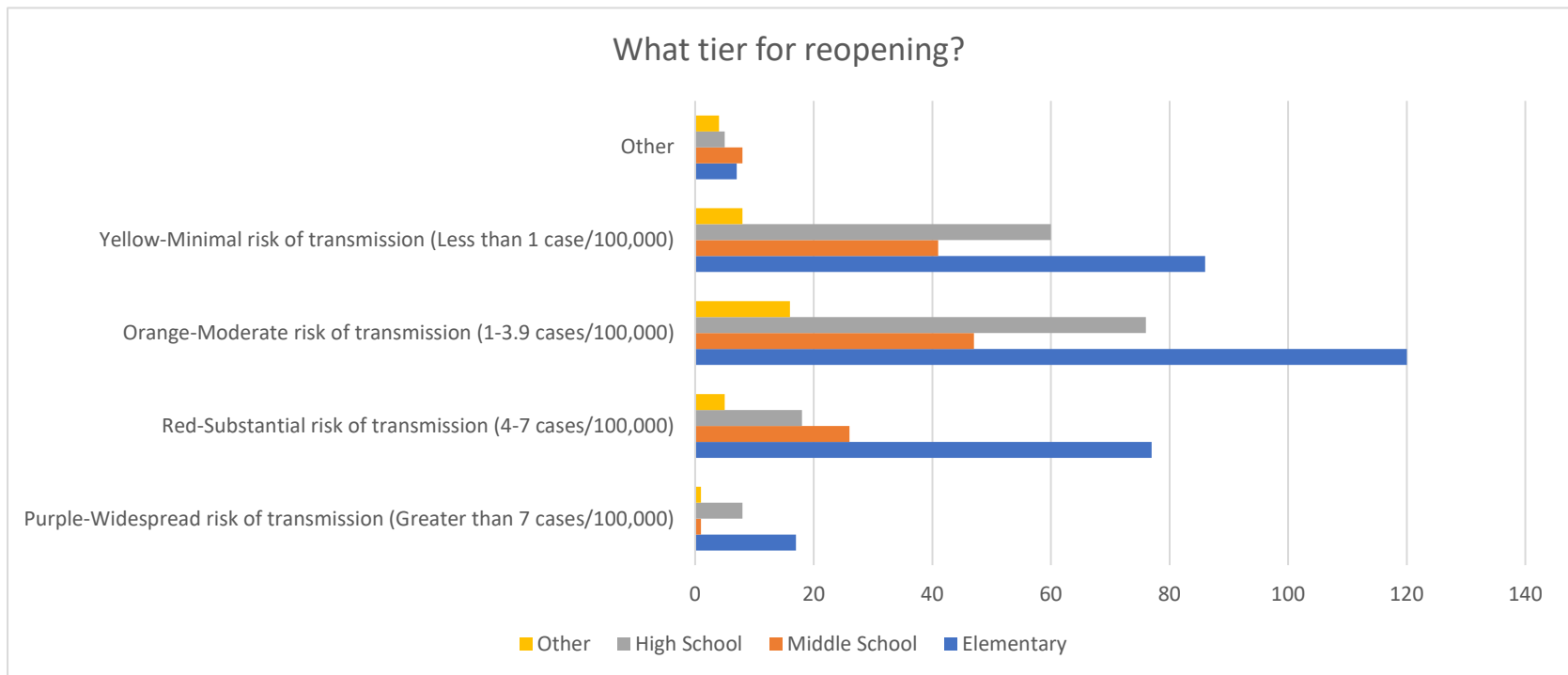


AEA COVID Campus Reopening Survey Results

The state has identified 4 colored tiers to indicate rate of spread of the corona virus. Which colored tier do you believe allows for the safe reopening of schools for in-person instruction?

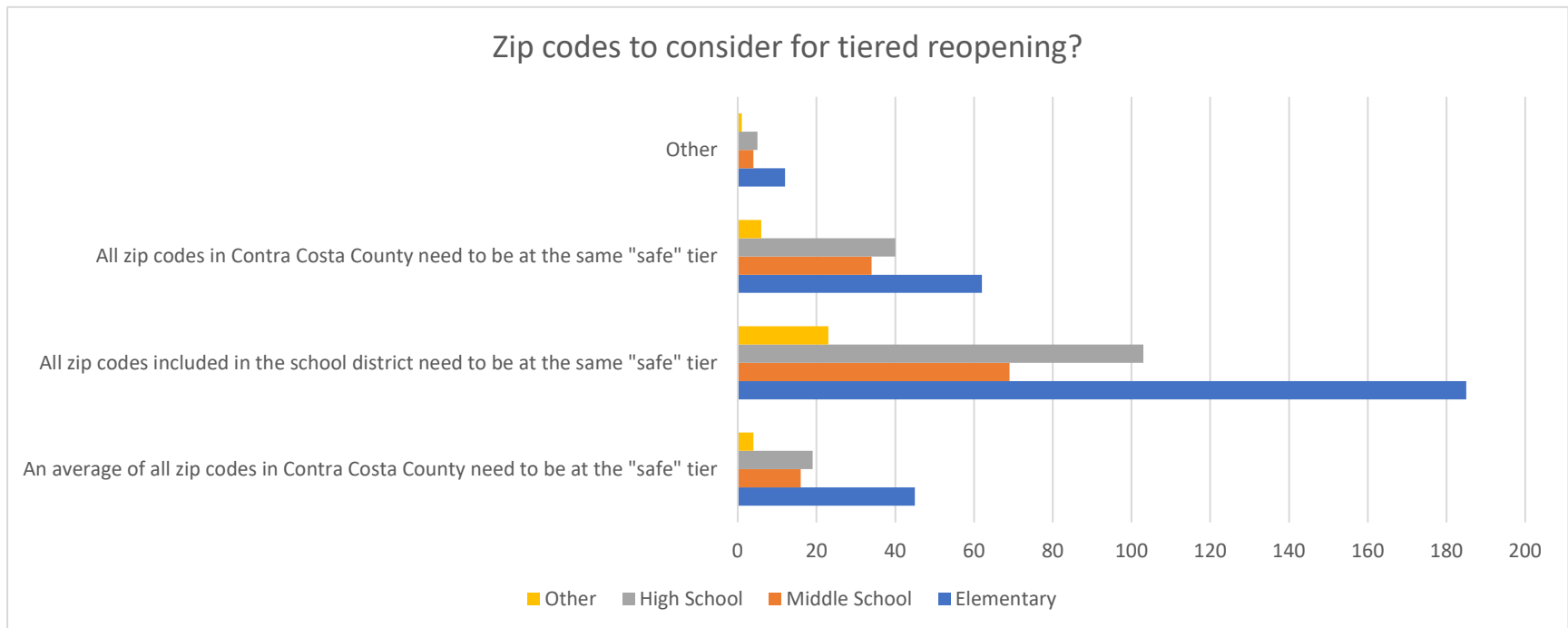

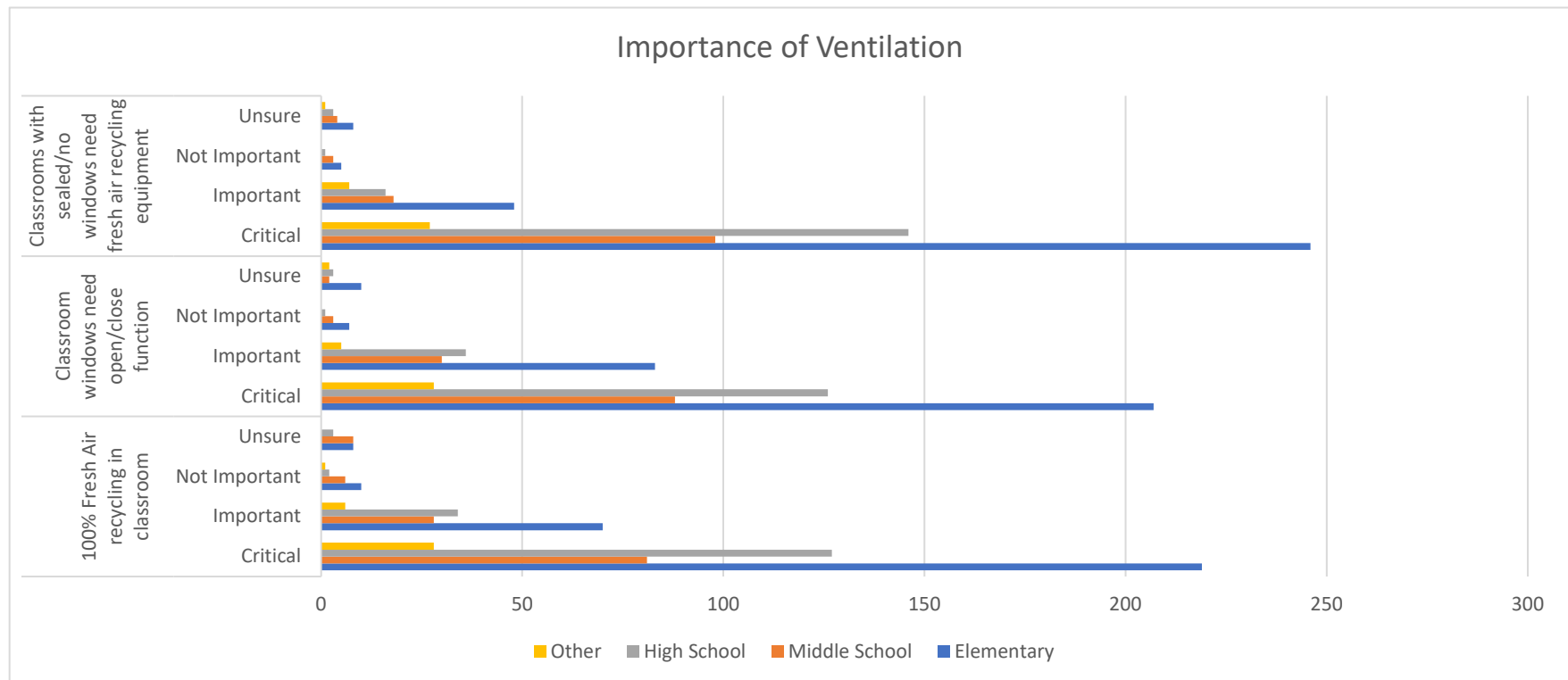

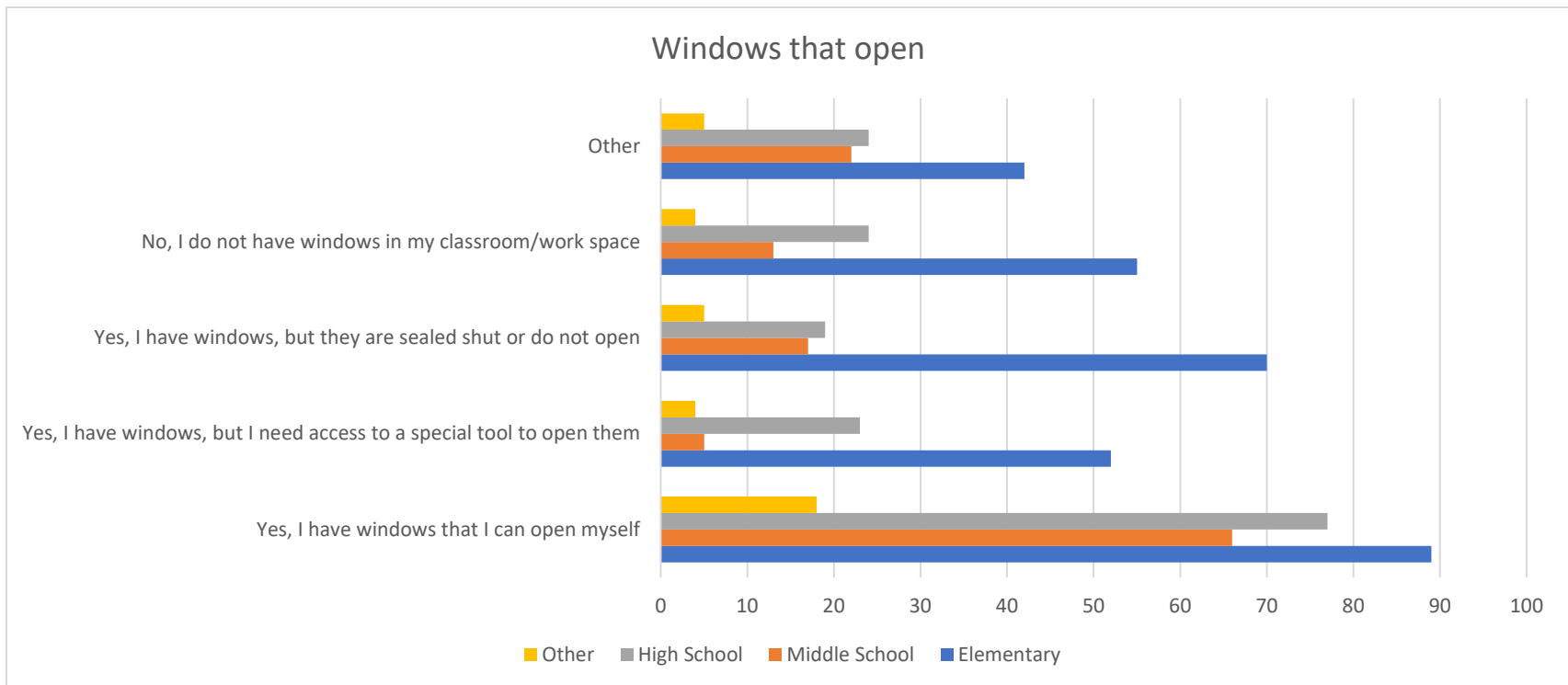

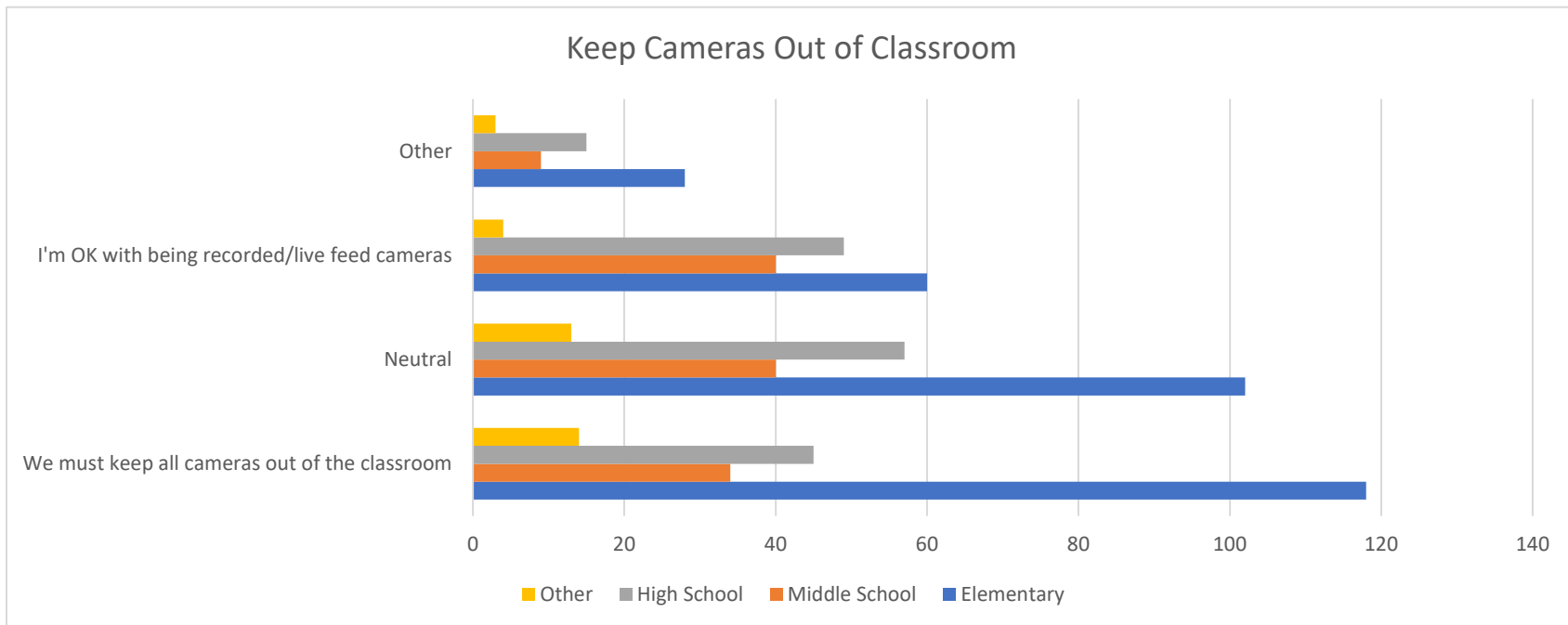

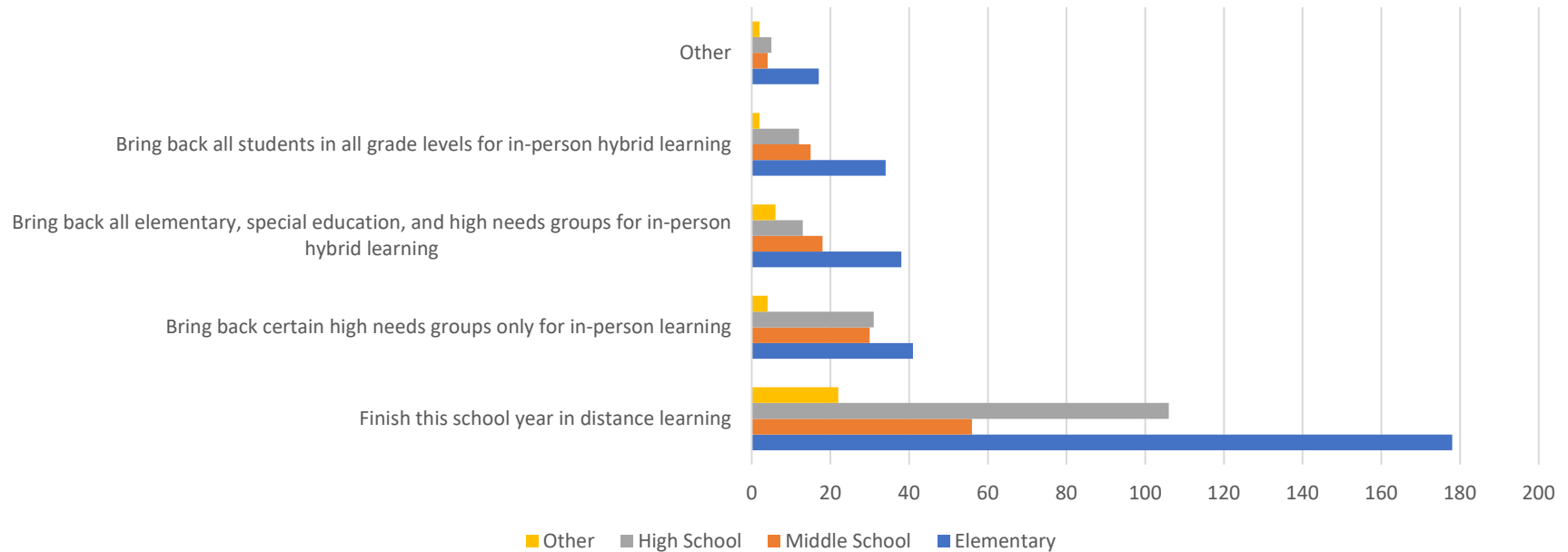

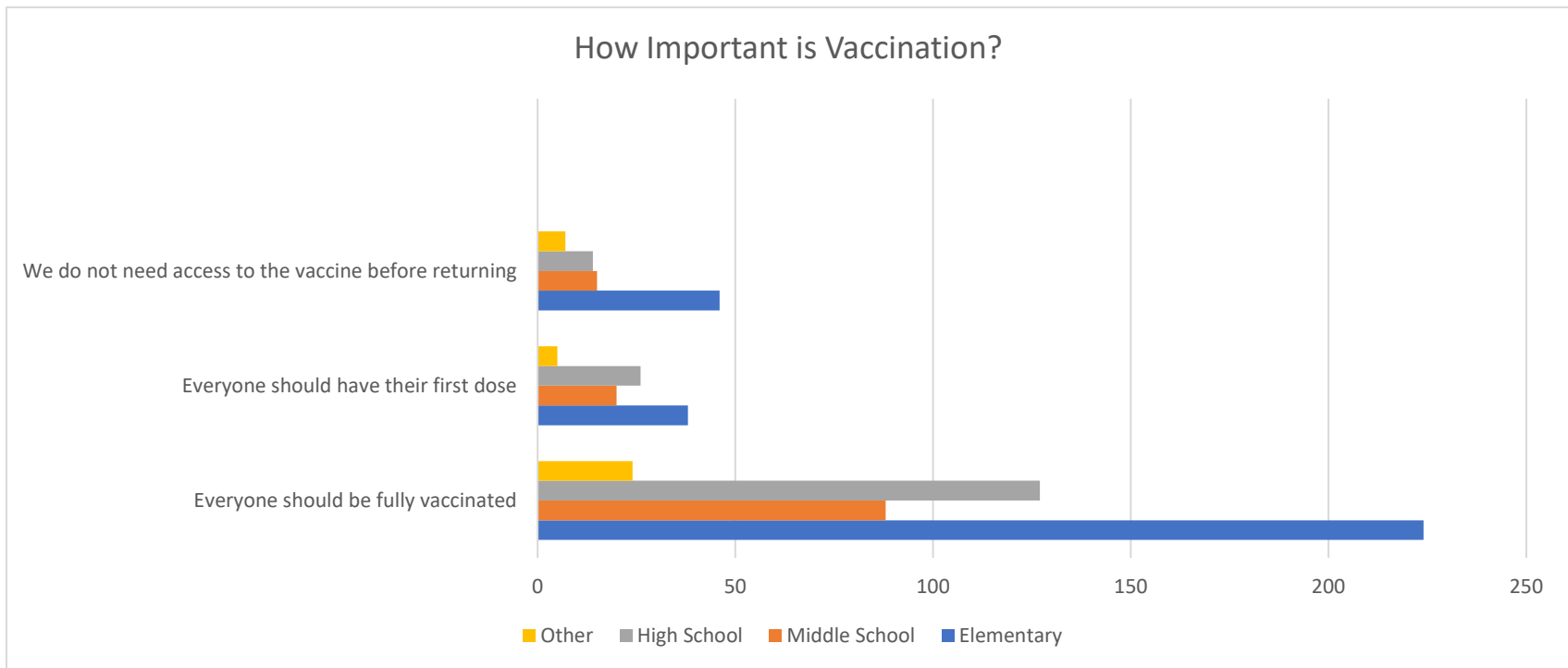

Preference for Rest of School Year



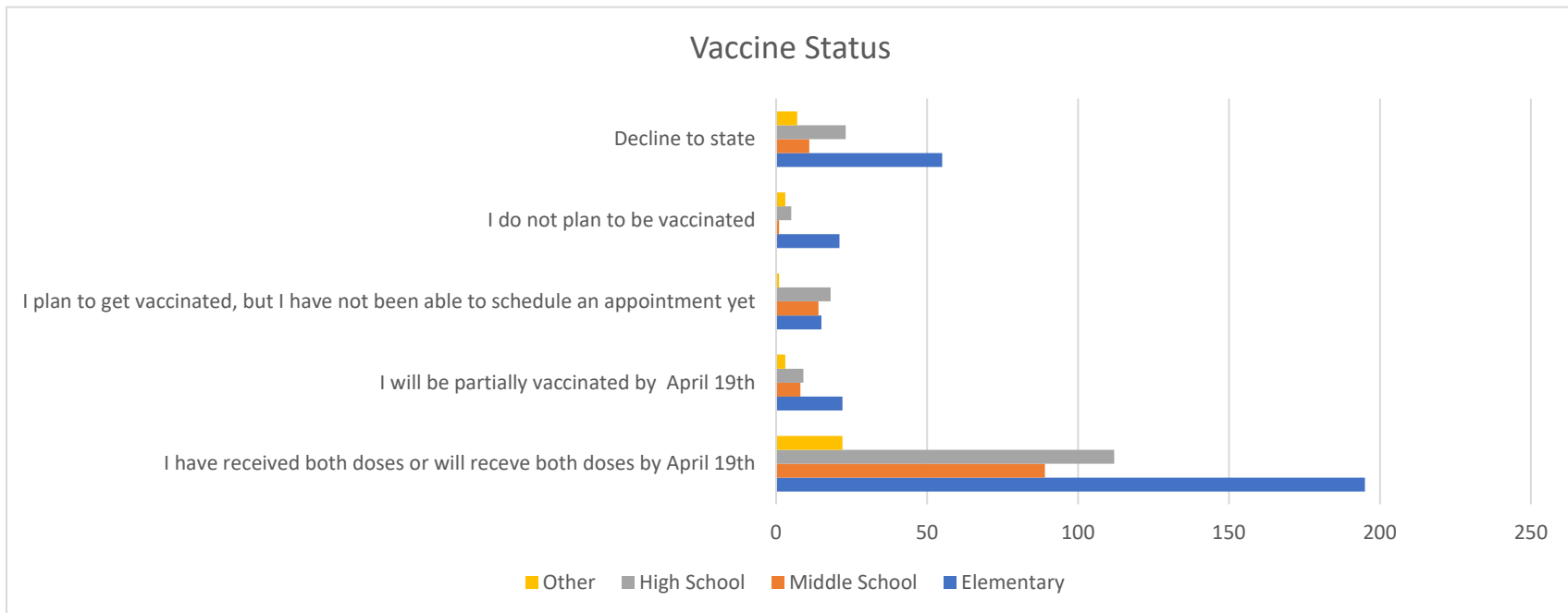

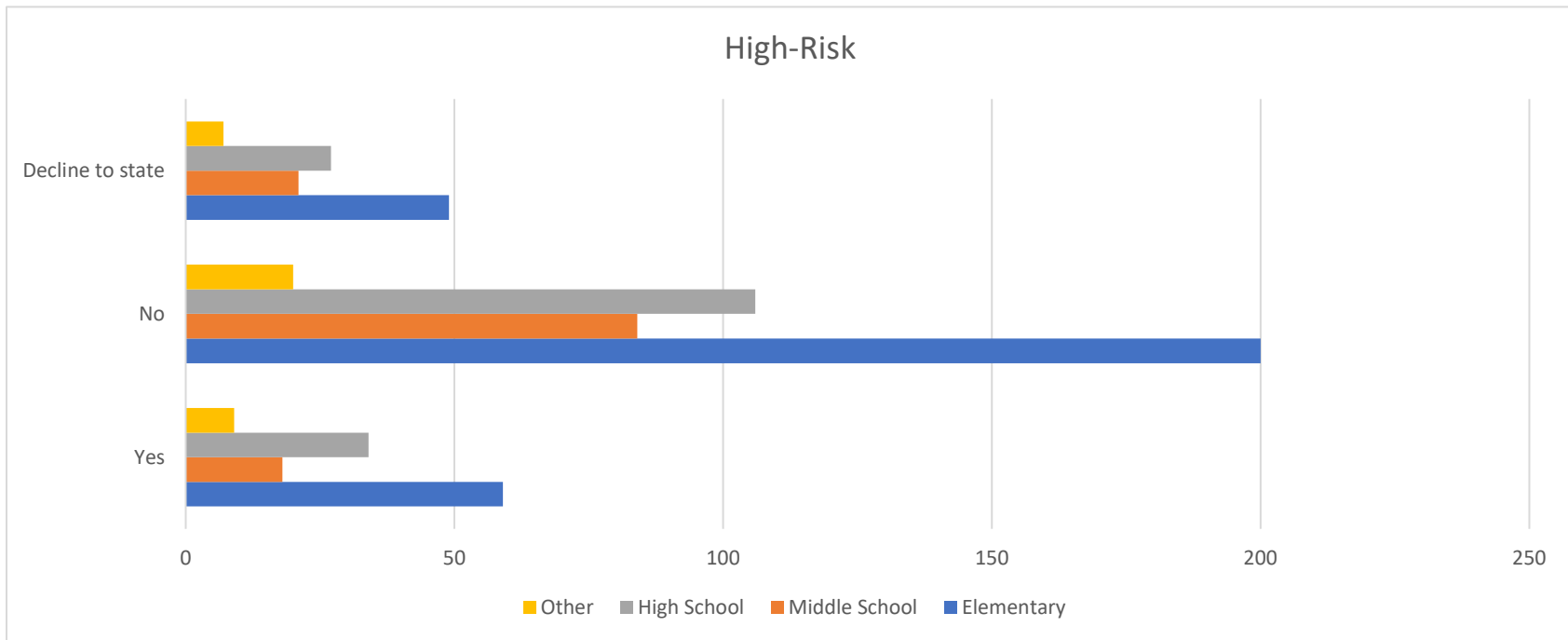

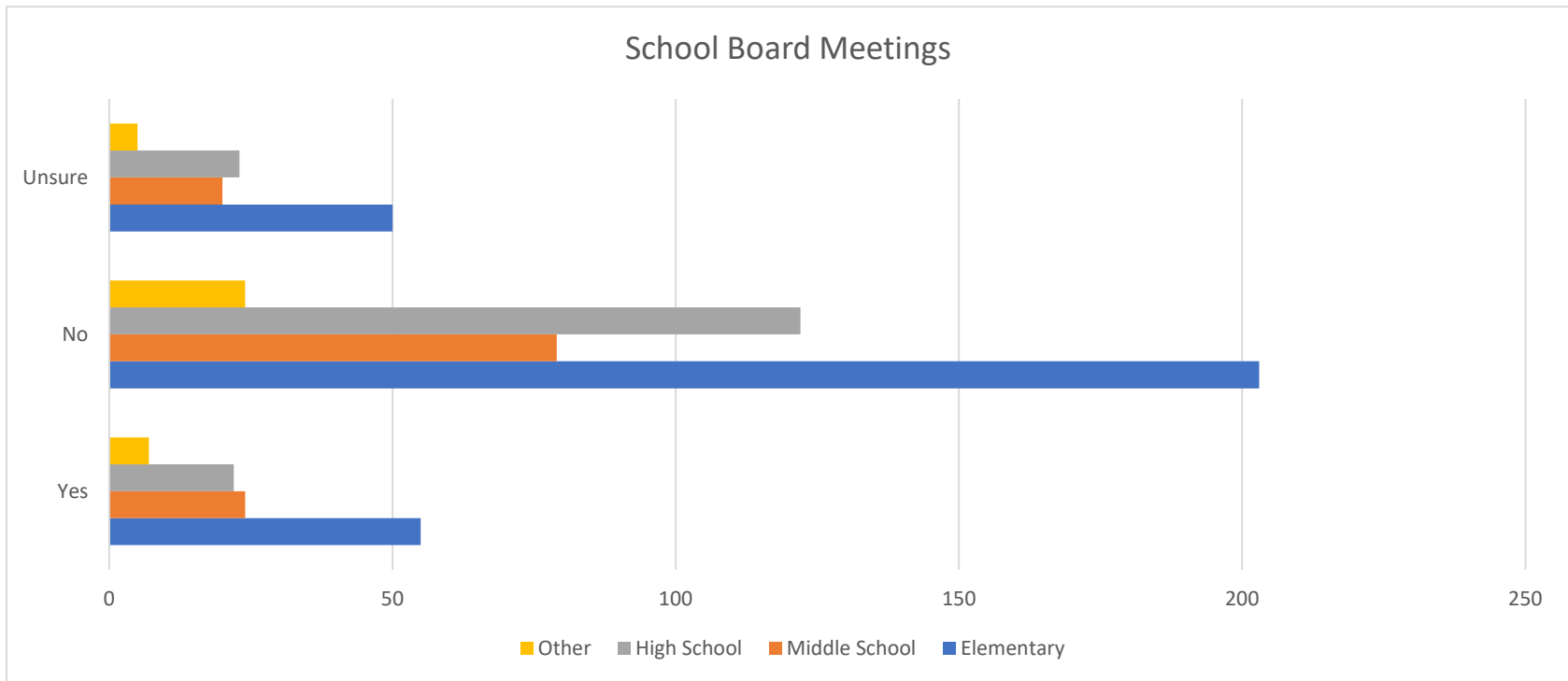

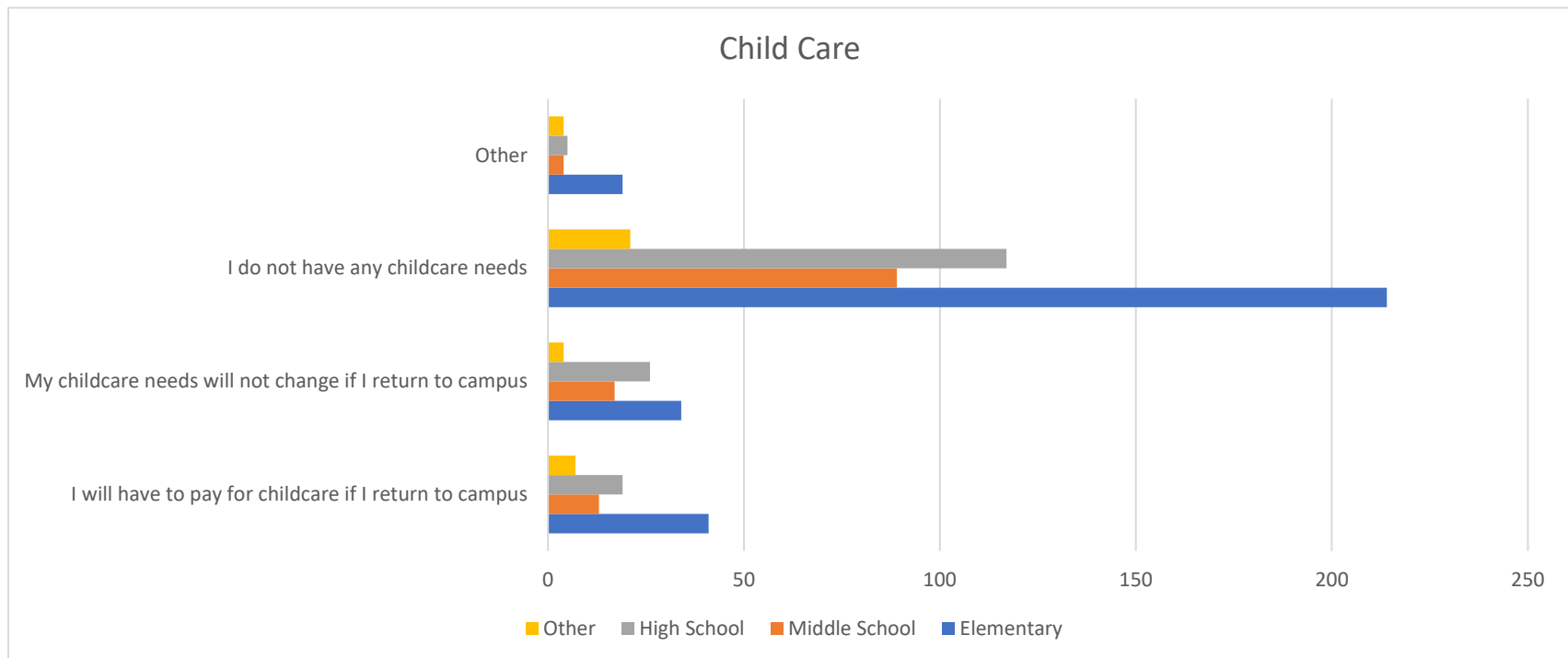
